1988 Amendments

To Ordinance 33

DEPUTY

to bail.

WHEREAS, County Ordinance No. 33, Section 4 sets a bail amount for violations of parking offenses under the Ordinance at \$5.00 and at \$10.00 if the bail is not paid within 24 hours, and

WHEREAS, these amounts are an inadequate amount of bail, the bail does not act as an adequate deterrent, and Sheriff's deputies find it impractical to enforce the ordinance given the present bail schedule, and

WHEREAS, a bail of \$25.00 is an appropriate bail.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED that:

County Ordinance No. 33, Section 4, is amended to read, in its entirety:

1. Section 4. Penalty; Bail.

"The penalty for violating any parking regulation under this ordinance shall be a fine not exceeding \$100.00; except as provided by Section 5(3). If the vehicle remains illegally parked after receiving first citation, each hour thereafter may be deemed a separate offense and a citation issued for it. Bail for a parking offense is \$25.00 (Twenty Five Dollars)."

- 2. New Section 7 of Ordinance 33 is enacted and shall read: "Overnight parking or camping within County parking areas is prohibited."
- 3. All other aspects of County Ordinance No. 33 remain in effect.

This ordinance being necessary for the public health, safety, and general welfare, an emergency is declared to exist for the passage of these amendments and this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
