This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of March, 2017. The Board being fully apprised of the records and files herein, finds as follows:

1. Settlement of disputes by mediation may lead to more long-lasting and mutually satisfactory agreements.
2. Mediation may reduce the need for time-consuming and costly litigation.
3. The Oregon Legislature has charged the State Board of Higher Education, acting by and through the University of Oregon on behalf of the University of Oregon School Of Law (Grantor), with the responsibility to foster the development of community mediation programs by making grant monies available to participating counties.
4. Any county wishing to participate must formally notify the Grantor of its intention to participate.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that:

5. Tillamook County hereby notifies the Grantor of its desire to be a participant in the expenditure of funds for community dispute resolution programs within Tillamook County.
6. Tillamook County agrees to engage in a process to select funding recipients both qualified by the standards and guidelines adopted Grantor and capable of and willing to provide community dispute resolution services according to the rules adopted by the Grantor.
