This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners, sitting as the governing body of the Solid Waste Service District (SWSD), on May 22, 2019, at the request of David McCall, Solid Waste Program Manager.

The Board of Commissioners, being fully apprised of the representations of the above-named person, and the records and files herein, finds as follows:

- 1. Walker Waste Solutions, dba City Sanitary Service has requested to increase rates charged by a collection franchisee to their customers.
- 2. Customer rates for this collection franchisee were last adjusted in Board Order #18-051, SWSD #18-009 and Board Order #18-072, SWSD #18-014.
- 3. The curbside commingled recycling collection service is organized and undertaken independently of the County's infrastructure and City Sanitary Service assumes responsibility for all costs and responsibilities associated with this service.
- 4. The Tillamook County Solid Waste Advisory Committee recommended at their meeting on May 7, 2019 that the requested rate increases be approved.
- 5. The Tillamook County Board of Commissioners finds that the proposed rates will be just, fair, reasonable, and sufficient to provide the proper service to the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

6. The City Sanitary rates as outlined on Exhibit "A" become effective July 1, 2019.

Dear Tillamook County Commissioners,

City Sanitary Service had a great 2018 celebrating serving Tillamook for 60 years. We did not have as profitable a year as we expected but remained a financially healthy business. We are requesting a rate increase of approximately 4% for the upcoming period from July 2019 to July 2020. Trash tipping fees will increase on July 1, dramatically increasing our largest expense. The requested rate increase combined with a drop in some of our expenses next year should bring our profit margin up to 10% in 2019-2020. This will put us comfortably in the allowable 8-12% range.

We added to our customer base by over 400 and increased tonnage volume in both trash and recycling in 2018. City Sanitary Service and Nestucca Valley Sanitary Service continued to bring cardboard recycling to south Tillamook County. We expanded commingled recycling to selected high population density pockets in the county and hope to open it up to our entire customer base in 2019 with your approval. We would also like to start a commercial cardboard recycling route in the Netarts area with commissioner approval. The annual recycling survey showed participation at our lot depot stayed steady and gave valuable information for the ban the bag effort. We plan to raise the rate for curbside commingled recycling service to \$4 per month as part of our two year plan to reach \$5 per month in 2020. City Sanitary Service made capital investments of roughly \$138,000 in trucks, carts, containers, and drop boxes in 2018 to meet the needs of our customers. The procurement of a cart washing truck in 2018 will help keep all customer garbage and recycling carts clean in the future. "Squishy Washy" as the drivers call the truck automatically washes carts and reuses the water after going through a filtration system. The system is environmentally friendly and 100% self contained. We continue to see an increase in customers paying bills online and setting up to receive electronic bills. Roughly a quarter of our monthly revenue comes from online payments. We continue to make updates to our website, publish a quarterly newsletter called WastEd, and post to our Facebook page to communicate with the over 400 customers that follow us. Thank you for allowing us to serve the citizens of central Tillamook County in 2018. We hope to expand our recycling programs to more areas of the county this year, keep customer carts clean, and continue to give a consistently high level of customer service in 2019.

Dear Tillamook County Customers,

City Sanitary Service will be increasing rates by approximately 4% starting July 1, 2019, pending the approval of the Tillamook County Commissioners. Trash tipping fees will be increasing to \$84.49 per ton for haulers and \$102.40 per ton for the general public at the Tillamook transfer station on July 1st. The minimum charge at all County transfer stations will be increasing to \$22.

Regular weekly service customers who bring their can or cart to the curb will see the rate go from \$18.70 per month to \$19.45. Extra cans will go from \$5.75 per can to \$6.00. Garbage cart, recycling cart, and container rent will stay the same at \$3, \$3, and \$18.60 per month respectively. The rate for curbside commingled recycling service will go from \$3 per month to \$4. We now provide this service to all customers upon request. Call today to set up recycling service. Truck labor for 10-15yd boxes will go from \$106 per hour to \$110.25 and 20-30yd box truck labor will go from \$112 per hour to \$116.50. Drop box rent will stay the same at \$13 per day or \$200 per month. The on-call or one time pick up rate will go from \$8.65 per can to \$9.00 per can.

Payments on an account that are returned could be subject to a \$10 non-sufficient funds (NSF) fee for each returned payment. Accounts that have service suspended due to non payment are subject to a \$15 return to service fee. Please keep your contact information up to date to avoid your account being viewed as abandoned. If your cart/container was removed due to apparent abandonment or delinquency a return to service fee of \$25 could be charged.

As a reminder for those with weekly service, if you are going to be gone for two weeks or more, you can contact us ahead of time to temporarily stop service and avoid being charged. If your can is not out but you did not call ahead, no credit will be extended.
