County Sheriff

This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on July 3, 2019 at the request of the Board Chair, David Yamamoto. The Board of Commissioners finds as follows:

1. Andy Long, the elected Sheriff, has given notice that he will resign effective August 1, 2019.
2. ORS 236.210(1) provides that the Board shall appoint a person to perform the duties of County Sheriff until the vacancy is filled by election.
3. Pursuant to ORS 204.016, the Board must appoint a person who is a United States citizen, an elector under the Oregon Constitution, and a resident of the county for a period of one (1) year preceding the next election.
4. Jim Horton meets all statutory requirements, has worked in the County Sheriff's Office for the past 21 years, and currently serves as Lieutenant.
