This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on April 3, 2020. The Board of Commissioners, being fully apprised, finds as follows:

1. Each person or business that collects payment for occupancy of transient lodging is required to register, collect the tax, and file quarterly returns with the Tillamook County Department of Community Development.
2. The next quarterly return for January 1, 2020 through March 31, 2020 is due on April 30, 2020.
3. Under the emergency powers granted by ORS Chapter 401, on March 14, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution \#R-20-005 designating a State of Emergency within Tillamook County due to the spread of the COVID-19 virus.
4. Tillamook County hospitality industry businesses are being severely financially impacted by the COVID-19 virus.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

5. The deadline to file the transient lodging tax quarterly return for January 1, 2020 through March 31, 2020 is extended to July 31, 2020. Late fees and interest shall not accrue for this return between April 30, 2020 and July 31, 2020.
