RESOLUTION
#R-21-003

This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on March 17, 2021. The Board of Commissioners, being fully apprised of the records and files herein, finds as follows:

1. Under the emergency powers granted by ORS Chapter 401, on March 14, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #R-20-005 designating a State of Emergency within Tillamook County due to the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19).
2. On March 22, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #20-006 continuing the emergency and closing within Tillamook County all county, state, and federal parks, all county parking lots, beach accesses, and certain parking areas along road rights-of-way, and all county public boat launches to non-commercial users.
3. On February 24, 2021 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #21-002 continuing the emergency through May 1, 2021.
4. Although the emergency still exists, the Board deems it is appropriate to continue a safe and strategic reopening of county facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the following is effective at 8:00 a.m. on Friday, March 26, 2021:

5. The beach access at the Pacific City Turnaround be open to the public seven (7) days per week.
6. The Tillamook County Public Works Department will install informational signage on the west end of the parking area to guide pedestrian traffic safely over the dune.
7. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Tillamook County Sheriff to close the beach access at the Pacific City Turnaround at his sole discretion at any time in the interest of public safety.

8. This resolution in the matter of opening the beach access at the Pacific City Turnaround shall remain in effect, unless otherwise closed by the Tillamook County Sheriff or amended by the Board of Commissioners.
