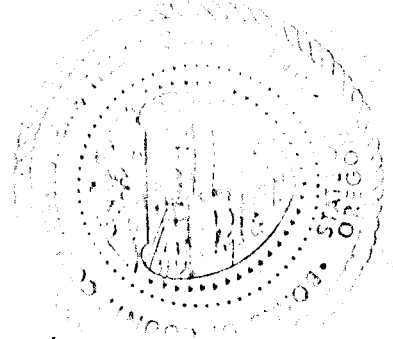
1. On April 3, 2020, the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners signed Order #20-015 implementing budget reduction strategies during the COVID-19 emergency.




NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:


