This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on November 9, 2021. The Board of Commissioners, being fully apprised, finds as follows:

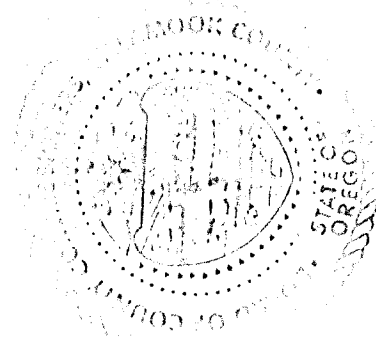
1. On August 27, 2021, the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners signed Order #21-046 closing certain county offices during the COVID-19 emergency.
