Request

Tillamook County Public Works has received a letter from Chief James Oeder of the Nestucca Rural Fire Protection District requesting that a permanent "No Parking Zone" be placed on a portion of Amity Avenue.

Background

The area proposed for a no parking zone is the westernmost block of Amity Avenue. This area has significant physical encroachments on the Southern and Northern boundaries of the right of way. The northern encroachments include retaining walls from all of the abutting properties. During the summer, vehicles parked along the roadway present a substantial impediment to emergency vehicles and delivery trucks trying to access the Condominium and neighboring residences. The letter marked Exhibit '1' further explains the parking issue and is attached to this Staff Report.

Discussion

James Oeder, Nestucca Fire Department Fire Chief, is requesting that a permanent "No Parking Zone" be placed on a portion of Amity Avenue.

"I am supporting the placement of no street parking signs. With parking on the street it has made entering the street hard for emergency vehicles to enter. If we had a major event in that area we would not be able to get equipment close at times.

If we had no parking signs on both sides of the emergency access and at least one side of Amity Avenue would improve our ability to enter these areas. Please let me know if I can be of further assistance on this issue."

Recommendation

Tillamook County Public Works supports the creation of a permanent No-Parking Zone.

A permanent No-Parking Zone removes the need for staff to continually place temporary signage (that may be removed or stolen), thereby using time more efficiently.

A permanent No-Parking Zone will ensure that Amity Avenue will remain accessible to emergency vehicles during any season of the year.


