This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on July 6, 2022. The Board of Commissioners, being fully apprised, finds as follows:

1. The Tillamook County Board of Commissioners acts as the local road authority in accordance with ORS 810.010 and ORS 810.160.
2. For the reasons of public health, safety, and welfare, on May 20, 2020, the Board of Commissioners adopted Order #20-019 establishing a "No Parking" zone on Cape Kiwanda Drive, from its intersection with Circle Drive to Pacific Avenue.
3. It is now in the county's best interest to allow parking on the west side of Cape Kiwanda Drive, from its intersection with Circle Drive to Pacific Avenue.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT, effective immediately:

4. The east side of Cape Kiwanda Drive, from its intersection with Circle Drive to Pacific Avenue, be and is hereby declared as a "No Parking" zone except as defined in ORS 801.380.
5. The Tillamook County Public Works Department shall install the appropriate signs for regulating this zone.
6. Copies of this order shall be sent to the Tillamook County Sheriff.




