1.	The current Tillamook County Parks Department fees are established in Board Order #20-051.			
2.	Oregon Revised Statute 811.635 provides that a "Wheelchair User" placard or decal and an "Oregon Wounded Warrior" placard or decal allows its holder, or another person while transporting its holder to or from the parking location, to (a) park a motor vehicle in any public parking zone restricted as to the length of time permitted therein without incurring penalties imposed for overtime parking in such zones, and (b) park a motor vehicle in any public parking zone with metered parking without being required to pay any parking meter fee.			
3.	The Board finds it prudent to amend Order #20-051 to recognize those fee exemptions listed above which are granted by State statute.			
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT effective on August 30, 2023:				
4. :	Provision #12 of Order #20-051 is amended as follows:			
	A day use access pass or annual day use access pass is not required to park in day use areas and boat launches (a) on days with a valid Tillamook County Parks' campground reservation, or (b) when displaying a valid Wheelchair User placard or decal or Oregon Wounded Warrior placard or decal.			
5.	All other provisions set forth in Order #20-051 remain in effect.
