Day Use Access Parking Fee Program Q & A

Why are you charging a fee?

The Tillamook County Parks Department's budget is designated a Special Revenue Fund. This means that the Parks Department is removed from the county General Fund and *RECEIVES NO FUNDING FROM THE COUNTY*. Since FY 2009/2010, the Tillamook County Parks Department has been self-supporting and has relied on the revenue it generates for its operations.

What do you do with the funds that are collected?

The fees that are collected at day use areas and boat launches help fund those facilities. Fees may be used to pay for restrooms and restroom maintenance, chemical toilet rental, garbage collection and pickup, vault toilet pumping, utilities (water, electric and sewer), parking lot striping, asphalt patching, gravel parking lot replacement, chemical applications, landscape maintenance, storm damage cleanup and repairs, launch and ramp maintenance and signage.

How much is the fee?

You may pay a daily rate of \$10.00 or an annual rate of \$55.00.

Do you offer reduced rates or discounts?

We offer a \$45.00 discounted rate on our Annual Day Use Access Pass for seniors over the age of 65, disabled veterans, and Oregon Trail card holders.

Where can I purchase a day use access pass?

Daily Day Use Access Passes are available at Tillamook County Parks and Pacific City Parking Management facilities. To purchase an Annual Day Use Access Pass, please visit Barview Jetty County Campground in Rockaway beach or call (503) 322-3522 to purchase one over the phone.

DAY USE AREAS:

ANDERSON HILL COUNTY PARK: Parking area located at the end of Officer Row in Tillamook. Picnic tables, hiking and equine trails. (45.422975°, -123.794410°)

BARVIEW JETTY COUNTY CAMPGROUND: Located at 8000 Cedar Ave. in Rockaway Beach. Parking, beach access, north jetty access, sandhill access, fishing, hiking, playground, restrooms and showers. (45.569297°, -123.944862°)

BAYOCEAN PENINSULA: On Bayocean Rd. and Bayocean Dike Rd. in Tillamook east of Cape Meares. Historical/heritage area, wildlife preserve, beach access, south jetty access, fishing, hiking, bicycling, running. Be respectful of private landowners; camping is not allowed. (45.506704°, -123.943551°)

CAPE KIWANDA RECREATION AREA: Parking area located off Hungry Harbor Rd. in Pacific City. Beach and Cape access, fishing, surfing, kayaking, restrooms. (45.215620°, -123.969927°)

HAPPY CAMP BEACH ACCESS: Parking area located at the end of Happy Camp Rd. in Netarts. Netarts Bay beach access, kayaking, clamming, restroom. (45.440206°, -123.954535°)

KILCHIS RIVER COUNTY CAMPGROUND: Located at 10500 Kilchis River Rd. in Tillamook. River access, hiking, fishing, playground, horseshoes, restrooms and showers. (45.536980°, -123.785113°)

PACIFIC CITY TURNAROUND: Parking located at the junction of Pacific Ave. and Sunset Dr. in Pacific City. Beach access, equestrian beach access. No trailers. (45.202302°, -123.966460°)

TRASK RIVER COUNTY CAMPGROUND: Located at 25455 Trask River Rd. in Tillamook. River access, hiking, fishing, horseshoes, restrooms. (45.441095°, -123.611326°)

WEBB COUNTY CAMPGROUND: Located at 33005 Cape Kiwanda Dr. in Pacific City. Parking, restrooms, showers. (45.216059°, -123.969272)

WHALEN ISLAND COUNTY CAMPGROUND: Located at 25210 Sandlake Road in Cloverdale. Historical/heritage area, estuary access, wildlife preserve, hiking, picnicking, kayaking, restroom. (45.273173°, -123.948612°)

WOODS COUNTY CAMPGROUND: Limited parking, restroom. (45.211058°, -123.954368°)

BOAT LAUNCHES:

3 RIVERS BOAT LAUNCH: Drift boat access to the Nestucca River, unimproved ramp; located at the end of Hanson Rd., ½ mile south of Hebo on Hwy. 101. (45.233645°, -123.875326°)

ALDERVALE BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access to the North Fork Nehalem River, unimproved ramp; located off North Fork Rd. in Nehalem. (45.768078°, -123.842868°)

BIXBY BOAT LAUNCH: Drift boat access to the Nestucca River, unimproved ramp; located off Bixby Rd. approximately ½ mile east of Beaver. (45.273078°, -123.833699°)

BURTON FRASER BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access to the Tillamook River, plank road ramp; located off Fraser Rd. at the intersection of Tillamook River Rd. (45.430277°, -123.846511°)

FISHERS POINT BOAT LAUNCH: Drift boat access to the Nestucca River, unimproved ramp; located off Brooten Rd. in Pacific City. (45.193224°, -123.955079)

HUNGRY HARBOR BOAT LAUNCH: Doryboat and restricted access to the Pacific Ocean, concrete and plank road ramp, beach launch; located at the Cape Kiwanda Recreation Area in Pacific City. (45.215720°, -123.971089)

KILCHIS RIVER COUNTY CAMPGROUND BOAT LAUNCH: Drift boat access to the Kilchis River, unimproved ramp; located at the day use area of Kilchis River County Campground in Tillamook. (45.538984°, -123.784081)

LAKE LYTLE BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access to Lake Lytle, unimproved ramp; located off NE 12th Ave. in Rockaway Beach. (45.627311°, -123.938551°)

LITTLE NESTUCCA BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access to the Little Nestucca River, unimproved ramp; located off Meda Loop Rd. east of Pacific City. (45.159291°, -123.936223°)

MAPES CREEK BOAT LAUNCH: Drift boat access to the Kilchis River, unimproved ramp; located off Kilchis Forest Rd. at the intersection of Kilchis River Rd. (45.519673°, -123.828223°)

MEMALOOSE POINT BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access to Tillamook Bay and the Tillamook River, improved launch, dock; located off Bayocean Rd. in Tillamook. (45.470958°, -123.890908°)

MILLS BRIDGE BOAT LAUNCH: Drift boat access to the Wilson River, unimproved ramp; located 6 miles east of Tillamook off Hwy. 6. (45.470721°, -123.739210°)

NEHALEM BAY BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized access to Nehalem Bay and the Nehalem River, improved launch, dock; located on Hwy. 101 between Nehalem and Wheeler. (45.706728°, -123.886013°)

NETARTS LANDING BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access, improved launch, dock; located at the junction of Netarts Bay Dr. and Netarts Basin Boat Rd. in Netarts. (45.431364°, -123.945949°)

PACIFIC CITY BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access to the Nestucca River, concrete launch; located off Sunset Dr. in Pacific City. (45.196365°, -123.966625°)

PARKS LANDING BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access to the Kilchis River, concrete launch; located off Idaville Loop Rd. ½ mile east of Hwy. 101 in Tillamook. (45.494951°, -123.846007°)

ROY CREEK BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access to the Nehalem River, unimproved launch; located on Foss Rd. ¼ mile east of Miami Foley Road in Nehalem. (45.702629°, -123.839608°)

SOLLIE SMITH BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access to the Wilson River, concrete launch; located at the junction of Wilson River Loop and Latimer Rd. (45.476719°, -123.808030°)

STEINER BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access to the Trask River, unimproved launch; located on Long Prairie Rd. ¼ mile east of Hwy. 101 in Tillamook. (45.426944°, -123.818323°)

WHALEN ISLAND BOAT LAUNCH: Motorized boat access to Sand Lake, tidal influence, unimproved launch; located at the entrance of Whalen Island County Campground. (45.273407°, -123.947767°)

NO PASS IS REQUIRED TO VISIT:

MUGG PARK: Restrooms and picnic area off Brooten Rd. in Pacific City.

NETARTS COMMUNITY PARK: Playground on Park Ave. in Netarts.

TILLAMOOK TIDEWATER HANDICAP FISHING ACCESS: Near Bayocean Road off Hwy. 131 in Tillamook.

TWIN ROCKS TURNAROUND: Beach access off South Breaker Ave. in Rockaway Beach.

CAPE MEARES BOAT LAUNCH: Pull-off on Bayocean Rd. east of Cape Meares.

*** Day Use Access Pass receipt, Annual Day Use Access Pass or valid camping tag required to access the fee areas above.**
