This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on May 29, 2020. The Board of Commissioners, being fully apprised of the records and files herein, finds as follows:

- Under the emergency powers granted by ORS 401.305, on March 14, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #R-20-005 designating a State of Emergency within Tillamook County due to the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19).
- 2. On March 22, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #20-006 continuing the emergency and closing within Tillamook County all county, state, and federal parks, all county parking lots, beach access, and certain parking areas along road rights-of-way, and all county public boat launches to non-commercial users.
- 3. On May 27, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #20-016 continuing the emergency through July 6, 2020.
- 4. Although the emergency still exists, the Board deems it is appropriate to begin a safe and strategic reopening of county facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the following is effective at <u>8:00 a.m.</u> on May 30, 2020:

- 5. The Cape Kiwanda parking lot shall be open to the public on weekends from 8:00 a.m. on Saturdays until 6:00 p.m. on Sundays.
- 6. All other county parking lots, beach accesses, and certain parking areas along road rights-of-way remain closed.
- 7. This resolution in the matter of opening the Cape Kiwanda parking lot shall remain in effect unless otherwise amended by the Board.
