This matter came before the Tillamook County Board of Commissioners on October 28, 2020. The Board of Commissioners, being fully apprised of the records and files herein, finds as follows:

1. Under the emergency powers granted by ORS Chapter 401, on March 14, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #R-20-005 designating a State of Emergency within Tillamook County due to the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19).
2. On April 22, 2020, the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #R-20-008 continuing the local State of Emergency through May 15, 2020.
3. On May 5, 2020, the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #R-20-010 further continuing the local State of Emergency through May 31, 2020.
4. On May 27, 2020, the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #R-20-016 further continuing the local State of Emergency through July 6, 2020.
5. On July 1, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #20-022 continuing the emergency through September 4, 2020.
6. On September 2, 2020 the Board of Commissioners signed Resolution #20-024 continuing the emergency through November 3, 2020.
7. The emergency still exists, and the Board deems it is necessary to extend the emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that following are effective immediately:

8. Resolution #R-20-024 continuing a local State of Emergency in Tillamook County is hereby extended and shall expire on January 2, 2021, unless extended by the Board.

9. Emergency procurements of goods and services continue to be authorized pursuant to ORS 279B.080, ORS 279C.335(6), and ORS 279C.380(4). Pursuant to ORS 279B.080, County department heads issuing emergency contracts shall set a solicitation time period that is reasonable under the emergency circumstances and may issue written or oral requests for offers or make direct appointments without competition.
