

## Cape Meares Road Relocation

# **Construction Activities & Upcoming Work**

Shotcrete placement continued throughout the week on the sides of the geofoam wall. Shotcrete placement is scheduled to be completed next week. Project signage, chain link fencing and approach gates made progress this week. Truck traffic between the south project entry and the adjacent Lighthouse Quarry will be minimal through project completion, however, construction traffic is expected to be steady on the closed portion of the old Cape Meares Loop for the next few weeks. Therefore, Tillamook County has prohibited pedestrian and bicycle traffic on the old roadway through project completion in Fall 2023. A two week time extension is anticipated for added fencing and guardrails.

### **ROAD CLOSURES**

Current road closure points will remain in effect on Bayocean Road near the Cape Meares Lighthouse, and approximately 0.5 miles south of the Lighthouse. Construction will have minimal impact on public traffic as it is closed to through traffic. Please be advised that project limits are now designated by barricades on Cape Meares Loop. coming south from Bayocean Road. See map on the following page for areas
