Sandlake Road: Culvert SL22

This grant request is for design and construction funding to remove failing AOP Barrier where Reneke Creek crosses Sandlake Road. Designs are partially funded.

Reneke creek has high-quality rearing habitat that is underutilized due to poor fish passage. A properly sized culvert or bridge would restore full access to 1.5 miles of rearing and spawning habitat. The headwaters in this system are in some of the most remote parts of the Siuslaw National Forest. Because of this the riparian consists of large trees and little impact from roads.

Salmon SuperHwy has been very successful in removing barriers in the Tillamook and Nestucca Watersheds.
