



Irish Road: Culvert 1700

This grant request is for design and construction funding to remove failing AOP Barrier where Irish Creek crosses Irish Road.

This project will restore full access to 1.9 miles of rearing and spawning habitat. This 1.9 miles of stream habitat is very high-quality complex cold-water habitat; it winds through private property protected by fences and is well shaded with the landowner planting additional cedar and hemlock trees along the stream this year. The only other barrier along this tributary to the Little Nestucca is a privately owned barrier above culvert 1700 that the SSH partnership is working to replace, opening an additional 0.8 miles.

Salmon SuperHwy has been very successful in removing barriers in the Tillamook and Nestucca Watersheds.
