COMPOST FACTS

THE UNITED STATES PRODUCES AROUND **34 MILLION TONS** OF FOOD WASTE PER YEAR



WASTED FOOD
FOOD CONSUMED

NEARLY **HALF** OF FOOD IN AMERICA GOES TO WASTE

ONLY ABOUT **5%** OF FOOD WASTE IS DIVERTED FROM LANDFILL



- The U.S. produces approximately **34 million tons** of food waste each year
- Food scraps make up almost **12%** of municipal solid waste generated in the U.S.
- Nearly half of the food in the U.S. goes to waste—approximately **3,000 pounds** per second
- Only about **5%** of food is diverted from landfill
